


## Chester Public Library Hotspot Borrower's Agreement and Policy

Chester Public Library offers mobile Wi-Fi hotspots for checkout to residens ages 18+ and in good standing with the library. Hotspots can be checked out for up to 2 weeks to access the internet on-the-go or in your home. The Hotspot, roughly the size of your palm, can be easily transported from place to place allowing internet access wherever you go.

- The Hotspot may be borrowed for up to <u>2 weeks</u>. No Renewals. Please call to reserve.
- The Hotspot must be returned directly to the Chester Library.
- The Hotspot must be returned to the circulation desk. DO NOT put in the book drop, this will result in a \$10.00 fine.
- The patron is responsible for damage, loss, or theft. Total replacement cost \$150.00.
- There is a \$1.00 per day fine if the item is not returned by the due date. *If a Hotspot is not returned on time, service will be discontinued*.
- This Hotspot allows users to access the internet. The Chester Public Library does not control the information accessible through the internet and does not accept responsibility for its content. The Library is not responsible for any personal information that may be compromised as a result of use of this device.
- I am responsible for the replacement cost for loss or damage as noted above.
- Patron's must be 18+ years of age with a library card in good standing.

## What is a Hotspot?

The Hotspot is an easy-to-use device that allows you to connect to your tablet, laptop, or other mobile device to the Internet wherever you are — at home, a road trip, an outing of some sort, etc.

## What can you do with a Hotspot?

**Internet service at home.** The library's hotspot can provide Internet access at home to fulfill your household's needs like research for school projects and papers, job searching and online applications, live streaming, and much more!

**Take it on a road trip.** Connecting your mobile device to a hotspot during a long car ride enables you to stream movies, music, or other online content without the risk of incurring data charges.

**Take it on vacation.** Do you not have internet access where you are staying (or no free Internet)? The hotspot will allow you to connect to the Internet and retain access to your favorite online sites and entertainment.

**Easy to use.** Make sure the Hotspot is fully charged. Press and hold the power button in front of the device until you see the Welcome appear. The device will activate automatically. Go to your WiFi settings and click on Franklin T9 1508 password d72810c4 which will connect you to the internet. You can also get this information by clicking the power key to go through the menu. To turn off, hold the power key until Goodbye is displayed.
